



## Heisenji Rokusenbo 5-color Kakimochi Rice Cakes

The five colors of the “Heisenji Rokusenbo Kakimochi,” a traditional confection handed down in this area since ancient times, are natural colors made from mugwort, shrimp, turmeric, black sesame, and wild rice. The additive-free and flavorful kaki (rice cakes) and arare (rice crackers) are a Heisenji specialty sold as souvenirs, or enjoyed in a variety of hands-on culinary experiences.
