



## Echizen Kawara Roof Tiles Factory Tour & Mini "Onigawara" Making Experience

Traditional "Echizen Tiles" have been protecting the roofs of Fukui for generations.

The factory, where large machinery and kilns operating at temperatures exceeding 1,200 degrees Celsius are in full swing, is a powerful place to visit!

This plan includes a tour of the factory and a hands-on experience of making miniature "onigawara" demon tiles.

Schedule	<p>Observe the production process of Echizen Kawara, roof tiles from Fukui. You can also make miniature "onigawara" demon tiles at the workshop.</p> <p>Schedule</p> <p>1. 30-minute factory tour After a brief explanation of Echizen Tiles and its history, the tour will then take you through the process of making the tiles, from clay mixing to molding, drying, glazing, and firing. This is an authentic Japanese factory tour where you get to experience the production process from its impressive scale and sounds, all the way to the heat that results from it.</p> <p>2. Making miniature onigawara demon tiles (30 min.) Using a plaster mold, make a miniature onigawara (demon's face). Make it your own by carving letters on its back.</p> <p>3. Firing We will dry, glaze, and fire the tiles, and send them to your home. The finished product will be delivered in about one month.</p>	Year-round (Monday to Saturday; 10:00~16:00)
