



Ichijodani Asakura Family Site Museum

The Ichijodani Asakura Family Site is the only site in Japan where the entire castle town of the Asakura Family Site, feudal lords who ruled Echizen Province(present-day Fukui Prefecture) during the Warring States Period, remains, and is designated as a special national historic site. As a gateway to the ruins, Ichijodani Asakura Family Site Museum was opened in 2022. Three main exhibitions—the remains of stone pavements, a one-thirtieth scale diorama of the castle town, and a life-sized model of the Asakura residence—tell visitors about the history of Ichijodani and how people lived at that time.
