Enjoy a full-course Wakasa Fugu meal at Gosaku, a pufferfish specialty restaurant that was visited by Emperor Showa and carries on the legacy of Gosaku Imai, the first in Japan to successfully farm tiger pufferfish. You'll also have the chance to experience a traditional tea ceremony and take a boat tour of the live tiger pufferfish tank (or, if the weather isn't favorable, explore the charming town instead).
