We also offer a special Shojin vegetarian cuisine, which is of a higher grade than the standard Shojin vegetarian cuisine.</li> <li>Shojin vegetarian cuisine can be prepared as a vegetarian or vegan meal.</li> <li>You may also watch video of Eiheiji in your room.</li> <li>Please notify the front desk by 17:00 on your check-in day if you wish to participate in morning services. There is no charge.* It may not be possible to participate in morning services during the first half of December and first half of February, due to Buddhist services. In this case, you will be provided with an alternative program.</li> <li>There is no dedicated space for wheelchairs in affiliated parking areas.
